TECHNICAL MEETING - PROCEDURES

CALL AREA PROCEDURES

- o Captains/coaches have to be in the call area 60 minutes before the scheduled start of the match for the draw.
- O Captain/coach who is late more than 5 minutes looses the right to the draw and the opponent can choose between team compositions A and B.
- o Captains/coaches have to write on the TOSS SHEET their names (in a readable way), names of the players, colour of the shirts and sign the toss sheet.
- The opposing teams/players DON'T HAVE TO wear shirts of different colours, but all players of the same team must be dressed uniformly and have their names printed on the back of their shirts.
- o Players have to bring their rackets to the call area 20 minutes before the start of the match for the before match racket control.

- O Substitutions have to be nominated after the end of the 2nd individual match.
- IF CAPTAIN/COACH DOESN'T COME TO THE CALL AREA 45
 MINUTES BEFORE THE SCHEDULED START OF THE MATCH, THE
 COMPETITION MANAGER WILL FILL IN THE TOSS SHEET FOR
 HIS/HER TEAM, NO COMPLAINTS WILL BE ACCEPTED!

OTHER PROCEDURES

CLOTHING:

- Players of the same team or double must be clothed uniformly shirts and shorts/skirts.
- o Players must have their names printed on the back of their shirts.
- O Dimension of advertising shall comply with the ITTF rules combined advertising area at the front may not be more than 600 sqcm (maximum of 6 clearly separated advertisements) and not more than 400 sqcm on the back (1 or 2 advertisements).
- o Advertising of tobacco goods, alcoholic drinks or harmful drugs is not allowed.

RACKETS:

- Rackets which were not presented in the Call Area for the before match racket control will be collected by the umpires after the individual match of a team match and examined in the Call Area.
- o Rackets which have been declared as not acceptable by the referee can be recovered at the referee's desk after the match.
- O During a team match rackets of all players will be kept at the assistant umpire's table until the end of the team match.

COACHING:

- There can be up to 5 persons on the bench.
- No medical stuff on the bench.
- o Advice may be given at any time except during rallies, but the continuity of play must not be affected.

PRACTICE:

o Practice in the playing hall is not allowed during the Group Stage Matches.
