7. Eligibility and Entry

U19 players shall be under 19 years of age on the 31st of December immediately before the start of the year in which the Championships take place (players born on or after 01.01.2005)

U15 players shall be under 15 years of age on the 31st of December immediately before the start of the year in which the Championships take place (players born on or after 01.01.2009)

Entries are open to:

- 7.1. Athletes of the ETTU Members Associations, except those defined under 7.2.
 - 7.1.1. Associations (except those defined under 7.2.) shall be entitled to enter up to 18 players, consisting of :
 - not more than 5 players participating in U19 boys singles, doubles and teams
 - not more than 5 players participating in U19 girls singles, doubles and teams
 - not more than 10 players participating in U19 mixed doubles (maximum 5 boys and maximum 5 girls)
 - not more than 4 players participating in U15 boys singles, doubles and teams
 - not more than 4 players participating in U15 girls singles, doubles and teams
 - not more than 8 players participating in U15 mixed doubles (maximum 4 boys and maximum 4 girls)
 - 7.1.2. The Organising Association shall be entitled to enter up to 20 players, consisting of:
 - not more than 6 players participating in U19 boys singles and doubles
 - not more than 6 players participating in U19 girls singles and doubles
 - not more than 12 players participating in U19 mixed doubles (maximum 6 boys and maximum 6 girls)
 - not more than 5 players participating in U19 boys teams
 - not more than 5 players participating in U19 girls teams
 - not more than 4 players participating in U15 boys singles, doubles and teams
 - not more than 4 players participating in U15 girls singles, doubles and teams
 - not more than 8 players participating in U15 mixed doubles (maximum 4 boys and maximum 4 girls)
 - 7.1.3. It is allowed to enter players only for individual events
- 7.2. Athletes of ETTU Member Associations with Belarusian or Russian passport, not representing any ETTU Member Association outside Belarus and Russia, as Individual Neutral Athletes (AIN) as follows:
 - 7.2.1. May enter players only for Individual events (singles, doubles and mixed doubles).
 May enter maximum 18 players with a Russian passport and maximum 18 players with a Belarus passport, consisting of:
 - not more than 5 players participating in U19 boys singles and doubles
 - not more than 5 players participating in U19 girls singles and doubles
 - not more than 10 players participating in U19 mixed doubles (maximum 5 boys and maximum 5 girls)
 - not more than 4 players participating in U15 boys singles and doubles
 - not more than 4 players participating in U15 girls singles and doubles
 - not more than 8 players participating in U15 mixed doubles (maximum 4 boys and maximum 4 girls)

7.2.2. Conditions of AIN participation:

- 7.2.2.1. AIN may be entered if they submitted to the ITTF the ITTF Additional Terms of Participation document and be granted acceptance by ITTF.
- 7.2.2.2. AIN may participate if the responsible authorities accept their entry into the hosting country.

7.3. Composition of Doubles and Mixed Doubles

7.3.1. it is allowed to pair players from different Associations.

8. Entry Fee

The entry fee paid to the Organising Association shall be 40 € for each participating Association and there shall be a levy of 125 € on each Association participating in a team event, payable to the ETTU.

9. Online entries

10. Substitutions

Associations can enter and modify their online entries until Monday 03.06.2024. (deadline for final entries). After the 03.06.2024. deadline, changes in the entries are possible until Wednesday, 10.07.2024. at 12:00 local time (CEST) by sending a request to the Competition Manager (competition@ettu.org)

After the draw for the team event, replacement(s) of players in a team can be accepted only if the total number of ranking points of the 3 (for Under 19 teams) or 2 (for Under 15 teams) highest-ranked players per team in the current ranking will not bring the team to a higher position after the replacement(s), than the position of this team that had been taken into account for the draw

Please note that after the final deadline, no additional player will be accepted. Only changes or cancellations will be accepted.

The individual events' seeding will be based on the July U15 European Ranking published 05.07.2024. The Ranking Committee may give special seeding positions to players if their World Ranking position is significantly higher than their position on the ETTU European Ranking.

A jury meeting with team delegates will take place at the venue on THURSDAY, 11.07.2024. at 19:00 CEST

An Association cancelling a person of their announced delegation after the deadline of the final entries up to 15 days before the tournament starts (until the 27.06.2024.) and arriving with less persons than announced has to pay a cancellation fee of 100 € per person to the organising Association.

An Association cancelling a person of their announced delegation during the last 14 days before the tournament (after 27.06.2024.) and and arriving with less persons than announced has to pay the 100 % of the hospitality costs of the initial booking for the whole period.

The organising Association shall provide 50% of the cost of hospitality (on the basis of the price for a double room) from the evening before the championships begin until the morning after they end for :

- up to 6 players of an Association entering at least 2 Under 19 teams or 1 Under 19 team and 2 Under 15 teams
- up to 5 players of an Association entering 1 Under 19 team and 1 Under 15 team
- up to 4 players of an Association entering 2 Under 15 teams
- up to 3 players of an Association entering 1 Under 19 team
- up to 2 players of an Association entering only 1 Under 15 team or only individual players
- up to 2 officials of an Association entering 4 teams
- 1 official only of any other Association entering teams or players

By entering the event, participants agree to abide by all ITTF and ETTU rules and regulations. All entered Associations and individual participants* agree to be under the auspices of the ETTU and its agents in all matters concerning television coverage, video, internet web casting, motion picture coverage, and photographic coverage of any kind. Participants* release all rights, or rights held by their agents or sponsors, in all matters relating to television and web casting coverage, video and motion picture coverage, and photographic coverage of any kind. A participant's* refusal of the coverage listed above may be subject to suspension or dismissal from the competition.

*holder of parental responsibility over participant in case participant is underaged.

In the context of betting participants shall not, by any manner whatsoever, infringe the principle of fair play, show unsporting conduct, or attempt to influence the course or result of a competition, or any part thereof, in a manner contrary to sporting ethics. Any violation of this principle shall be disciplined according to provisions of ITTF Regulations 3.5.3.

ETTU nor its media partner is offering ETTU events and competitions for underaged, to betting companies and so any betting opportunity is not controlled and not legal.

Each participating Association will be allowed to use one video camera to record matches of its own players. The video is only for its own use. It is forbidden to post the video online, as all rights belong to ETTU.
